About Polo Forest

Polo Forest was once part of a vast kingdom, with Vijaynagar as its capital around 600 years ago. The region served as a significant pilgrimage site for Jain and Shivadharmi communities. The ancient city was developed along the banks of the Harnav River and featured four intricately sculpted gates made from local sedimentary rock, positioned in each direction. Though many temples were destroyed during the Mughal era, their ruins now stand as heritage sites, reflecting the area's rich cultural and historical legacy.

Today, Polo Forest is a protected sanctuary known for its rich biodiversity. The dense jungle is home to wildlife such as leopards, bears, pythons, and spiders, along with over 600 species of trees. The Harnav River and reservoir support a variety of water birds and crabs. Maintained by the Dholwani Range Forest Department, the area is preserved for both conservation and tourism. A government-established campsite also promotes nature education and eco-tourism, making Polo Forest a unique blend of heritage and natural beauty.





Your Adventure Itinerary



Day 1 | Departure & Sunrise Trek

Departing from Ahmedabad at 1:30 AM, we'll reach Idar by early morning for a scenic sunrise trek to Ranivas, the highest point of Idar Fort. After soaking in the views and cool breeze, we'll descend to the base and head to the campsite. Post breakfast and tent setup, the day continues with local sightseeing, team games, and evening stories.





Day 2 | Trekking & Activities at Idar

Begin your day with a peaceful sunrise and hot tea at the campsite. Head to Abhapur for a guided trek to Maango Mountain, followed by a visit to the 15th-century Jain temples. After lunch and adventure activities at Invincible Highland, we'll return to Ahmedabad by 11 PM.
